

QUESTION 10: SURVEY ABBREVIATIONS

Relationship to Head of Household – use the following answers:

- 'Self'
- 'Parent'
- 'Child'
- 'Spouse'
- 'Sibling'
- 'Relative'
- 'Friend'
- 'Unknown'

Do not enter invalid answers such as 'Sister' or 'Brother,' but instead choose Sibling. For 'Aunt,' 'Uncle,' 'Cousin,' 'Grandparent,' etc., enter Relative. For 'partners' or 'significant others,' enter Spouse

Gender – use the following abbreviations:

- 'M' for 'Male (boy if child);'
- 'Wo' for 'Woman (girl if child);'
- 'CSI' for 'Cultural Specific Identity'
- 'T' for 'Transgender'
- 'NB' for 'non-binary; a gender that is not singularly 'Female' or 'Male''
- 'Q' for 'Questioning'
- 'DI' for Different Identity

Race/Ethnicity – Please write in all options the respondent identifies himself/herself or any household member as. Use the following abbreviations:

- 'AI' for 'American Indian/Alaska Native/Indigenous'
- 'B' for 'Black/African-American/African'
- 'AS' for 'Asian/Asian American'
- 'PI' for 'Pacific Islander/Native Hawaiian'
- 'WH' for 'White'
- 'ME' for 'Middle Eastern or North African'
- 'H' for 'Hispanic/Latin(a)(o)(x)'

**Hispanic/Latin(a)(o)(x)- A person of Cuban, Mexican, Puerto Rican, South or Central American or other Spanish culture of origin, regardless of race.*

* If the respondent is multiracial, please record each race that the respondent identifies for themselves, separated by commas. For example, for someone who identifies as Black/African-American/African and Asian/Asian American, write the following: B, AS

* If the respondent identifies with multiple genders, please record each gender that the respondent identifies for themselves, separated by commas. For example, for someone who identifies as Male (boy if child) and Transgender, write the following: M, T
